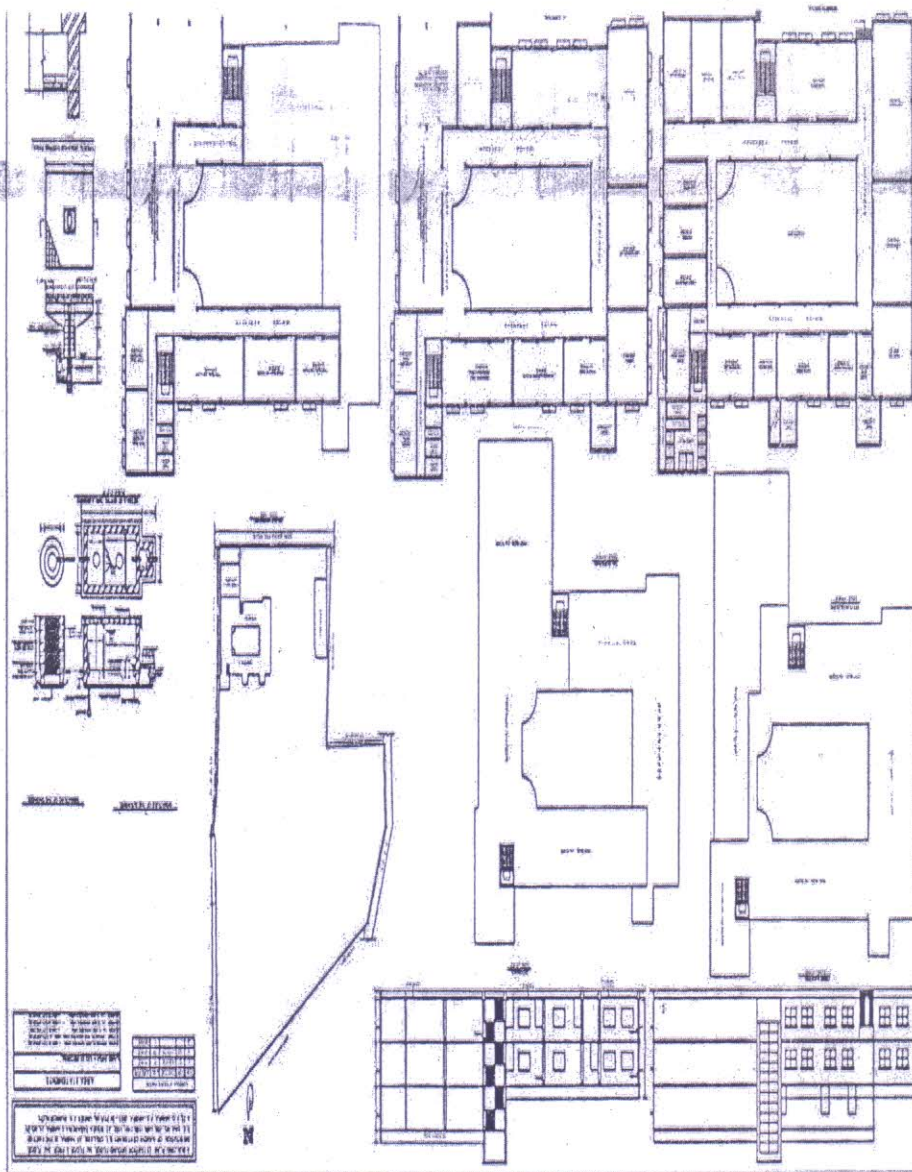

In relation to the matter as referred, I am to state that, our institution is under the administrative control of the Education Directorate and the Department of Higher Education, Govt of West Bengal. It is an institution aided by the Govt. of West Bengal. Dpt of higher education has already sent their proposal to the honourable regional director, NCTE-ERC for waiving a no. of such institutions (we are one of those) from deposition of the funds, as referred (vide G.O No. SS (T)/HE/60/2002, Dtd. 5 th September, 2002), copy of the GO enclosed. Hence, compliance of this item seems not relevant for us.

Though we have taken the initiative for deposition of these funds, further process has not been undertaken in view of this.

Sub : Endowment Fund for non-Government Teachers' Training Colleges in West Bengal - proposal for waiving the same.

Sir,

I am herewith sending a report on the aforesaid subject for consideration of the NCTE and a favourable decision in this regard.

2. There are 19(nineteen) non-Government Teachers' Training Colleges (B.Ed. Colleges) in the State which are almost entirely funded by the State Government (list enclosed). In addition, B.Ed. Course is taught in 15 non-Government General (Arts & Science) Colleges by their B.Ed. departments. These colleges were established with a view to promoting teacher education in different parts of the State with assistance from the State Government.

3. These Institutes are under the administrative control of the Education Directorate and the Department of Higher Education. The following measures have been taken by the Government to ensure proper management and control of these institutes :-

- i) Security of service and regular payment of salaries to the teaching and non-teaching staff are ensured by the West Bengal College (payment of salaries) Act, 1978.
- ii) The Governing Body of these institutes have one or two nominees of the State Government.
- iii) Death-cum-retirement benefit scheme has also been implemented for the welfare of the staff.
- iv) Teachers are appointed through the College Service Commission and creation of posts requires the prior approval of the State Government.
- v) Academic matters are controlled by the affiliating universities in the State.

4. The total expenditure on staff salary as well as infrastructure development and maintenance is almost entirely
